

The Faculty & Staff Perennial Garden



A shining example of the investment made by the Faculty and Staff of HPU, this garden was built upon the donations from their own gardens and implemented through their volunteer time. Originally planted with 122 different varieties, this is a dynamic garden with additions and changes made each year in order to grow and maintain the collection. In fall of 2013, we began the process of significant reworking of the garden. Much of the focus of this renovation focused on improving the soils in the garden and bringing more structure to the garden such that all seasons display interest, including winter.
